PRINCIPLE ON CODE OF ETHICS FOR STUDENT AND TEACHER, PRINCIPAL, NON-TEACHING STAFF AND ADMINISTRATORS

The code of conduct is derived based on the guidelines given by the University Grant Commission & Affiliated University.

Every teaching and non-teaching staff who is involved, directly or indirectly, in the preparation or submission of a bill to any government or private body is expected to use his or her best efforts to ensure the bill addresses only those services rendered and products delivered and in the correct amount, supported by appropriate documentation.
