10 CADETS SHINE IN MAHAVIR STADIUM PARADE ON 26TH JAN



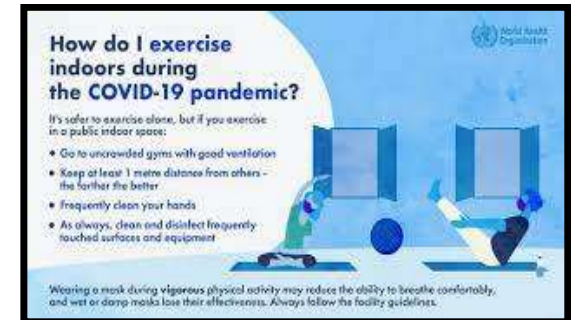
