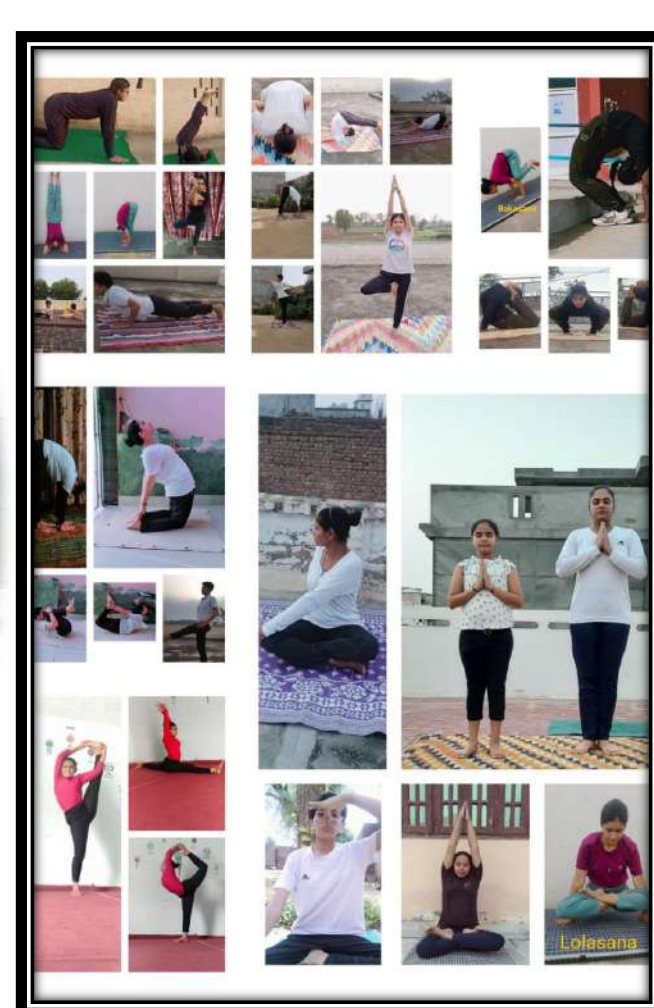
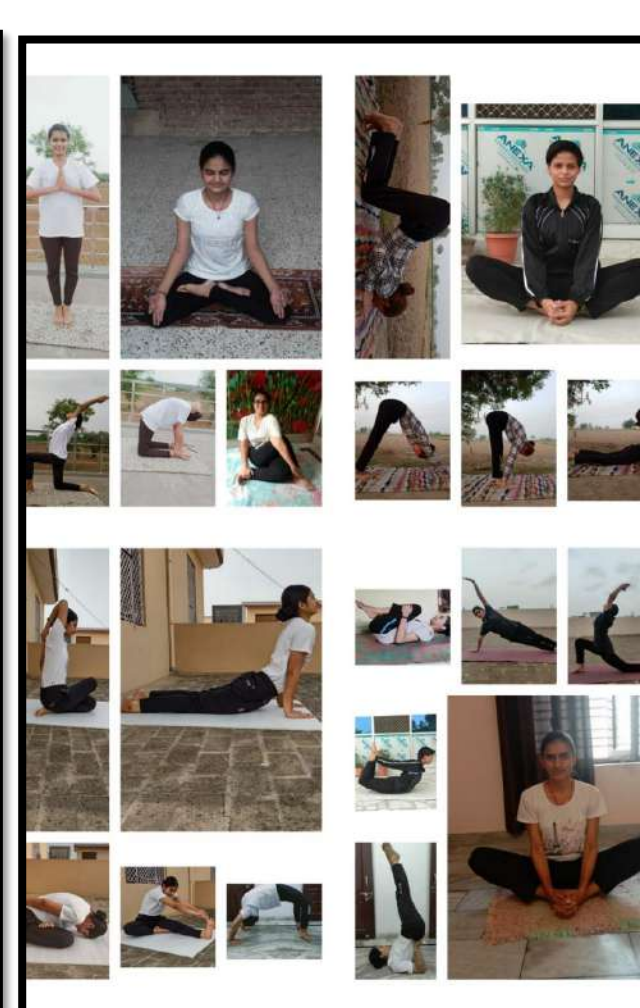

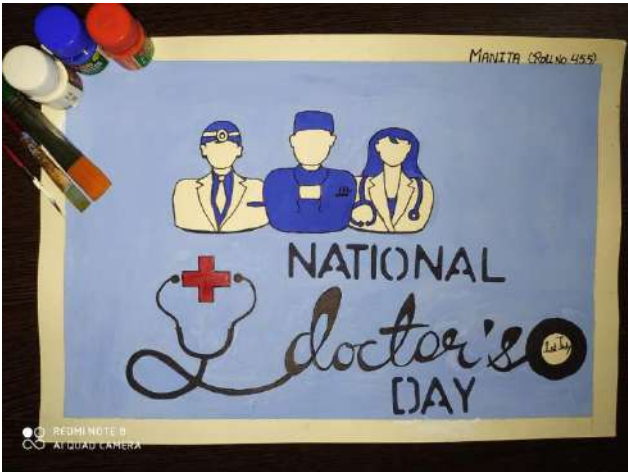




Empowering Wellness: 25 NCC Cadets Join the Global Celebration of Yoga Week, June 15-21, 2020

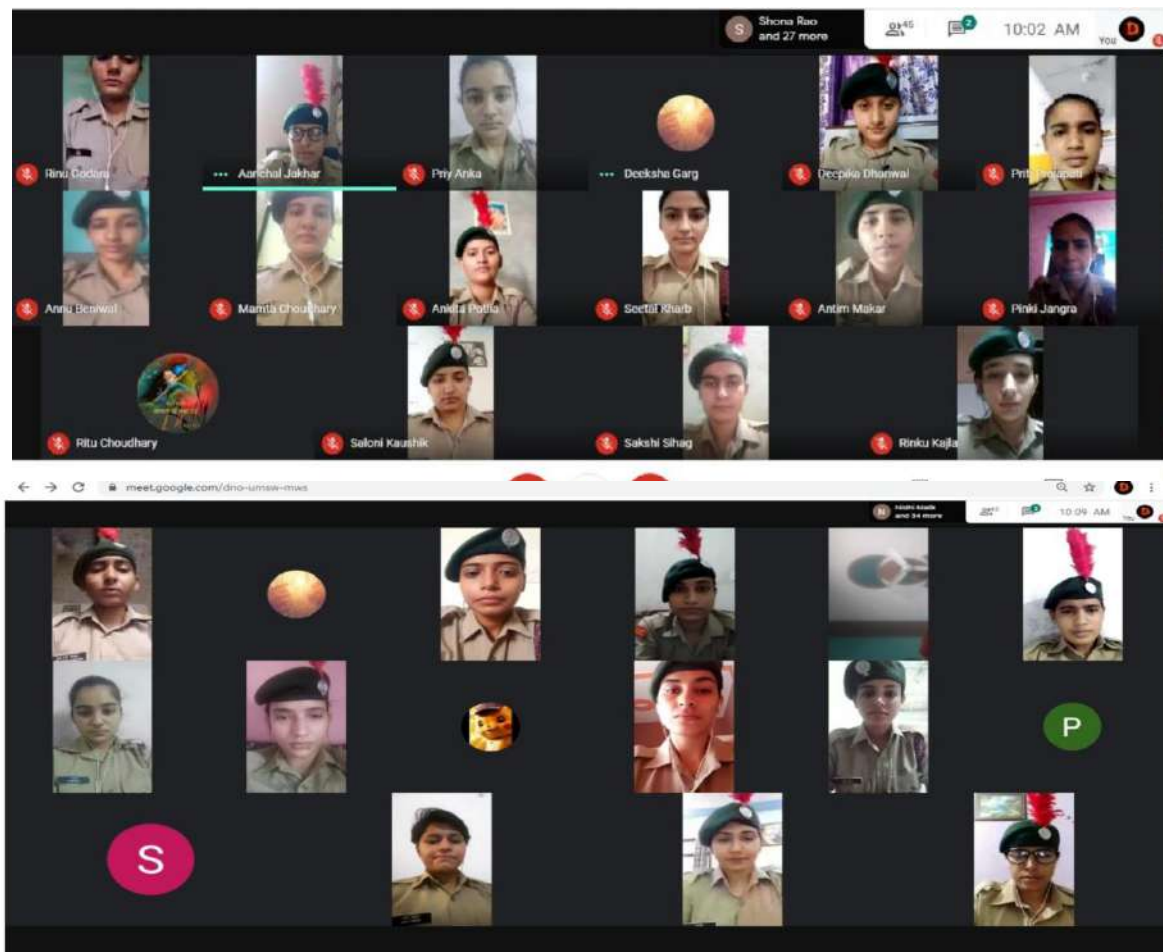

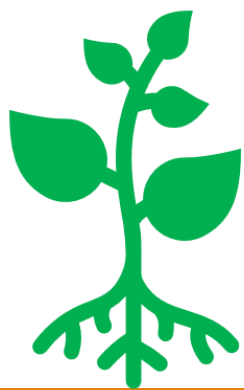
