








4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 1090 responses




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers. 1090 responses




7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.






10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes or programme outcomes.






12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications. 1090 responses




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




14. Teachers can identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them. 1090 responses




15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




16. The institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.






18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work. 1090 responses




