NSS volunteers participated in a state-level online essay writing competition organized by Shaheed Smarak Govt. P.G. College, Faridabad.

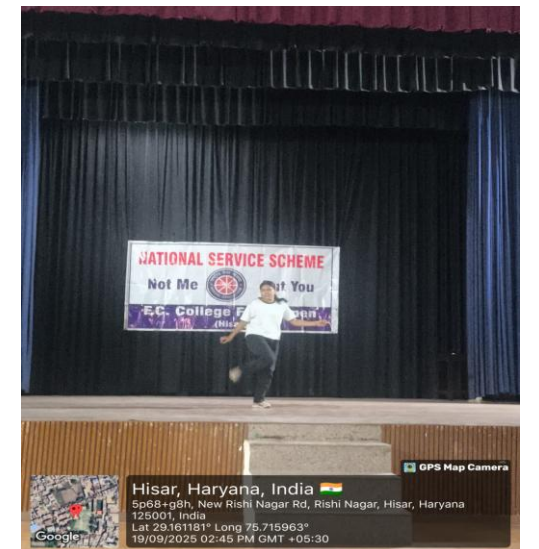
4. Lecture on Suicide Prevention (15th September, 2025)

- Dr. Monika from UPHC, Rishi Nagar, Hisar trained 50 NSS volunteers on administering polio drops and maintaining vaccine potency.



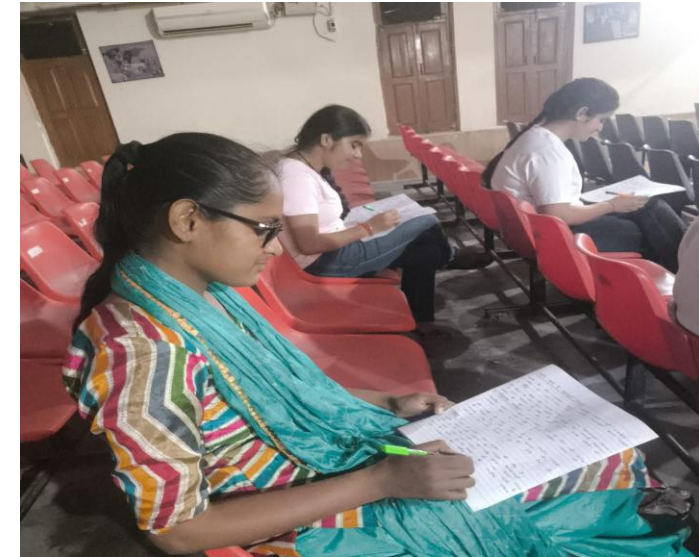
8. Pulse Polio Campaign (12 October to 14 October, 2025)

- 26 volunteers took part in the Pulse Polio Campaign under the supervision of Civil Hospital, Hisar. They distributed polio drops in their assigned areas.



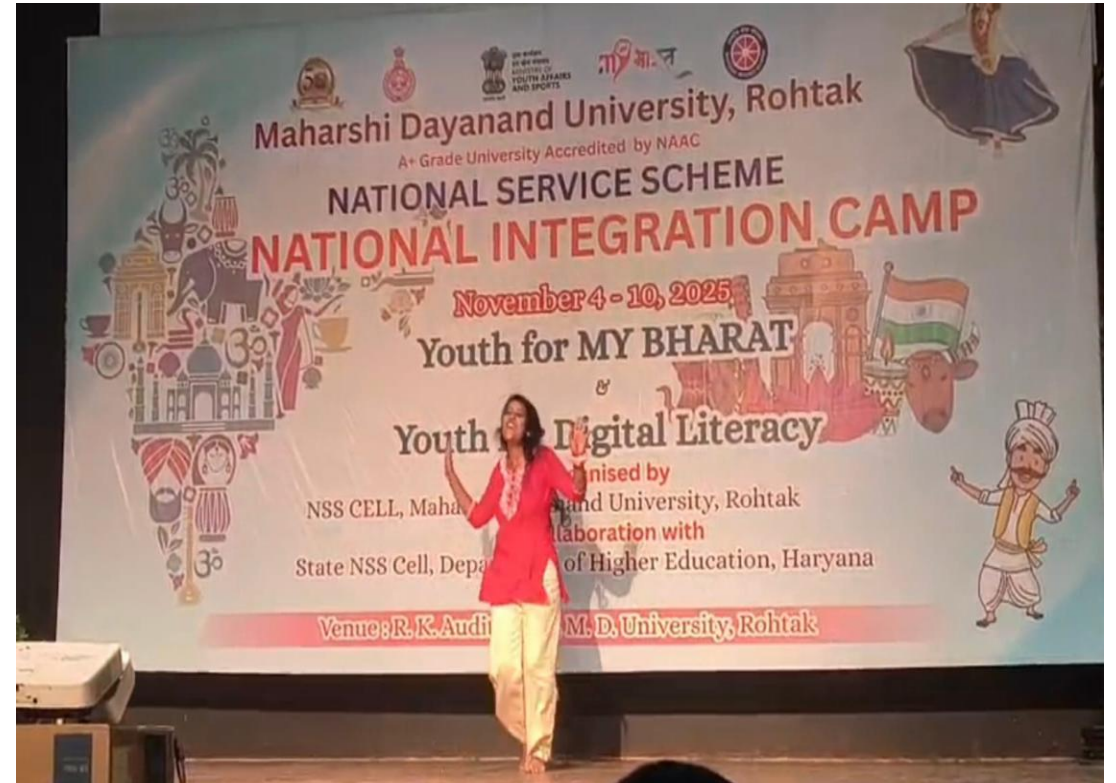
9. National Unity Day Celebration (31 October, 2025)

14. Swachhata Abhiyan (17 January, 2026)

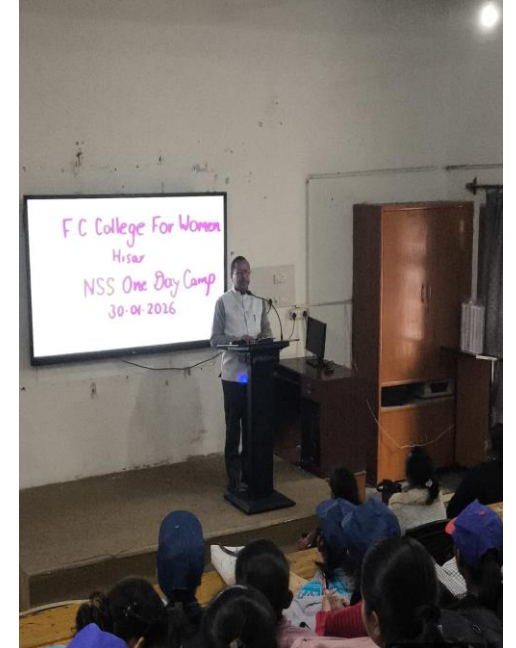

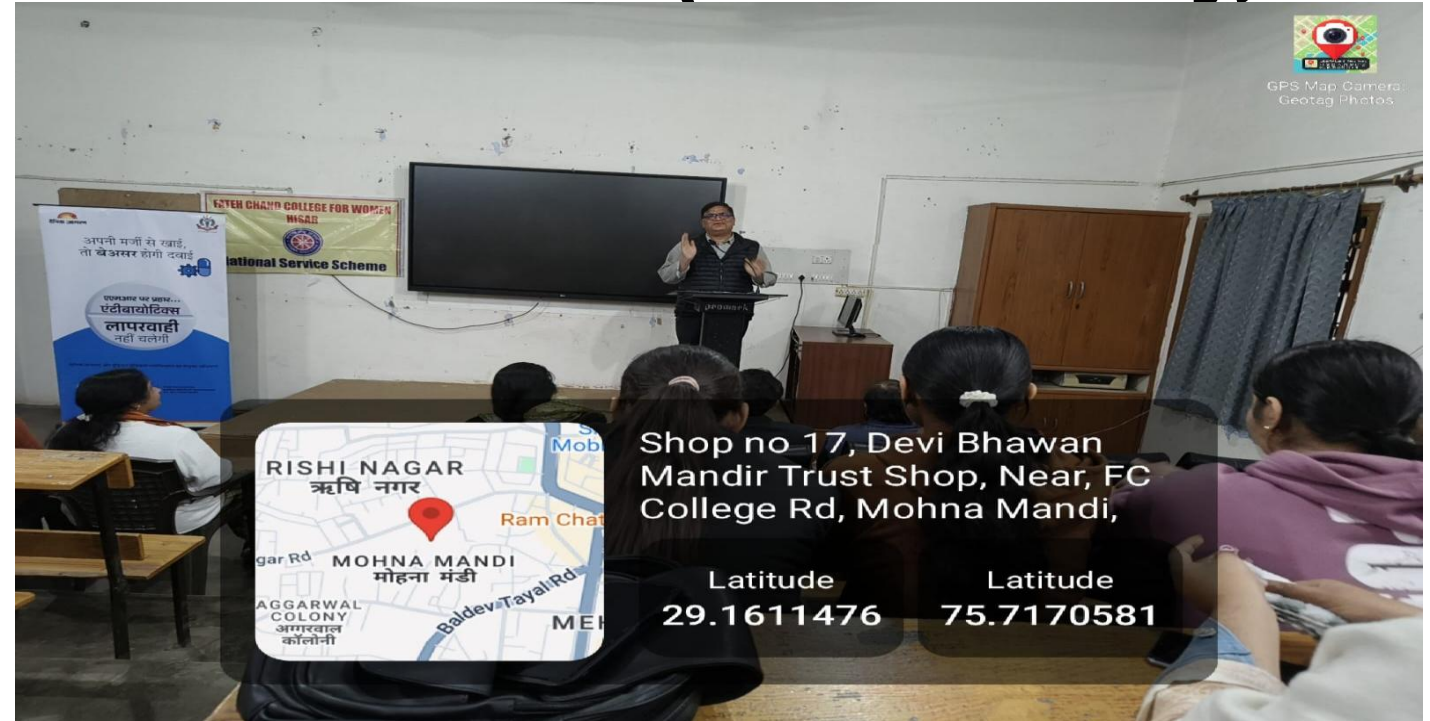
15. One Day NSS Camp (30 January, 2026)

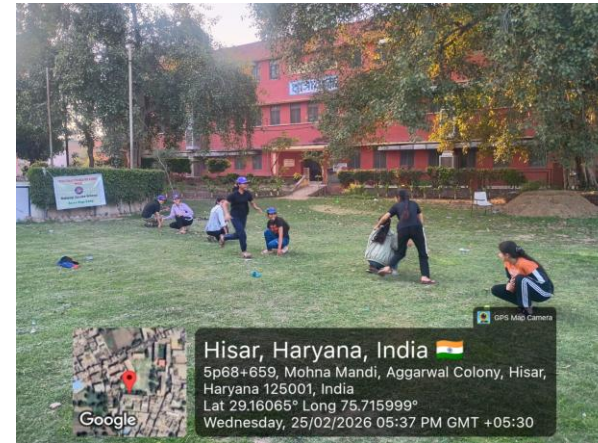
16. Antibiotic Awareness Session (18 February, 2026)

- The volunteers visited the adopted village Kaimri, where they performed a skit highlighting Suicide Prevention and Awareness. An Anti-Drug Addiction rally was also organized. Volunteers interacted with women in the community, motivating them to prioritize personal hygiene, a balanced diet, and regular health check-ups. They also visited Surbhi Kala Centre.
- Mr. Harish from Suraj Karate Academy, Hisar, provided Self-Defence Training, while Ms. Anju, a yoga trainer, conducted sessions on Yog and Pranayam. Mr. Kuldeep, Lecturer with District Red Cross, Hisar, imparted training on First Aid and CPR.
